Year 11 Prom

The prom will take place on Friday 24th June, from 7pm - 11pm at Priestfield Stadium in Gillingham. We have provisionally booked the venue, which requires a minimum number of 100 attendees. Therefore, students need to complete the form on the link below by Monday 21st February:

If this number is reached the booking will be confirmed and the event details are as follows:

The cost of each ticket will be no more than £45 and includes a DJ and disco, buffet, photo booth with free prints, red carpet, decorations and the venue hire. Students have been raising money in their Leadership groups to subsidise their Prom and so the final ticket price cannot be confirmed until 19th April. When confirmed, further details will be sent to you and tickets will be available on ParentPay and must be purchased by the deadline of Friday 13th May. When purchasing the ticket, parents and carers will also need to complete the consent form on ParentPay. The safety of students is our main priority, and the event will be supervised by Chatham Grammar staff who will register students on arrival and out again at the end of the event once they have seen the designated person collecting the student.

Study Leave and Leavers' Day


